This two-day training experience covers principles of program assessment and provides space for faculty to develop or revise an assessment plan or reporting practices in collaboration with peers and OAAA staff.

Applicants will be asked to include information about what program(s) they hope to apply the information to and to identify either an area of student learning or a component of their assessment process they are seeking to improve
