• Clinical Teaching - SP23

- We have 69 clinical student teachers and 3 new interns. Our candidates began clinical teaching on Jan 4 and already doing well
- Our EPP is in the process of awarding 2 candidates for <u>Educational</u> <u>Aide Exemption.</u>
- Early Field Experiences SP23
 - An email was sent to all instructors/course leads who teach courses with field experiences for initial certification explaining the application process and deadline. Students must submit their field experience application by Jan. 24.
- Please share this information with your students who plan to student teach in FA23. **The deadline to pass all exams is July 1, 2023.** Students who plan to student teach in FA23 need to complete the Clinical Teaching Application in TK20 between Feb.1 and Feb. 20. Here is more FAQ information to share with students who are planning to student teach in FA 23. The Fall 2023 supervisor orientation is August 2 from 9-12 via zoom and clinical student teaching orientation for all candidates is August 3 from 9-1 pm via zoom. The information is also shared with students who are in the pipeline to begin clinical teaching, but it is helpful for faculty to remind students as well.

- Student Recent Change of Majors: To Education Dec. '22
 - 6 major switches to Education, majority from Interdisciplinary Studies
- Student Recent Change of Majors: Out of Education Dec. '22
 - o 5 major switches out of Education to various other disciplines.
- TEA YTD Pass Rates Nov. '22
 - Few new tests taken the past month, namely Deaf and Hard of Hearing EC-12, Educational Diagnostician, Science 4-8, Social Studies, and Superintendent. Under Non-PPR Exams "Other" demographic category, the past rate has went down from 82% to 79%
- TEXES YTD (2022 2023) Pass Rate: Gender Dec. '22
 - School Librarian pass rate has gone down from 81% to 77% (female)
- TEXES YTD (2022 2023) Pass Rate: Ethnicity Dec. '22
 - Data reflects uptick in taking new tests. Science of teaching reading pass rate has gone up for all demographics.

- Field Experiences and Clinical Practices Committee Sarah McMahan and Jerry Burkett
 - Our committee met in December and provided feedback on the "Pathway to clinical teaching" document. <u>This</u> document is being edited and will be posted on our website soon.

 - o I have contacted all new and previous committee members to provide context of the Committee responsibilities and pertinent bylaws or policies related to our work. We had one student that requested a review. No report. There have not been any additional requests from students.

 - The committee met in December to begin the process of a "deep dive" into the Critical Friends report, creating a task force to address culturally sustaining practice, and a method for documenting existing culturally sustaining practices within the EPP.
