Speaker Report – Emarely Rosa-Dávila

There is currently testing of the Where is Oakley Now weekly writing challenge and for the interface between Oracle Cloud and Colleague. New faculty now are able to access email and university material 45 days prior to the start of the semester of hire with a signed contract. Faculty Development applications are with the Board of Regents. There is a plan to replace the Sedona program within a year. Regarding access to Artificial Intelligence program, we currently have access to Copilot (Microsoft product) and others may be considered.
