- 4. Be enrolled in coursework that is necessary to begin a career in teaching or plan to complete such coursework. Coursework that will prepare a student to teach in a high-need subject area (e.g., math courses for a student who intends to be a math teacher) is acceptable.
- 5. Be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or permanent resident.
- 6. Not have defaulted on or owe a refund to any previous student aid program.
- 7. Award will be prorated each semester based on enrollment status if less than full-time.
- 8. Maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined by the TWU Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress policy. These requirements are available on the TWU Student Financial Aid web site at www.twu.edu/finaid.
