Report from Dr. Carolyn Kapinus:

Degree Title Change Announcement

- Master of Arts (MA) in Music is changing to the Master of Music.
- Rationale: The title Master of Music aligns with the standards set forth by the National Association of Schools of Music and is in common usage throughout the United States. This more accurate reflection of the content and curriculum of the degree will allow for immediate recognition and understanding of the degree by both potential students and future employers.

Schweitzer Fellowship

Application Numbers Update

Spring numbers

- Completed master's applications are down 29% (199 apps).
- Accepted master's applicants are down 34% (116 apps).
- Completed doctoral applications are down 84% (474 apps).
- Accepted doctoral applicants are down 63% (15 apps).

THECB & SACSCOC Clarification

- There is some confusion about what requires THECB and SACSCOC approval. Dr. Gray Scott, Mary Rosene, and Dr. Kimberly Miloch crafted the document that is in the shared drive which outlines all the various actions that require notifications and approval.
- Two things to note:
 - o Increases in credit hours always require THECB review and approval. Changes that are 25% or more or less and students' expected time to completion increases or decreases by more than one term require approval of the SACSCOC Executive Council.
 - o We are required to obtain SACSCOC approval in advance before we stop accepting students to any program. There are no exceptions to this policy.
