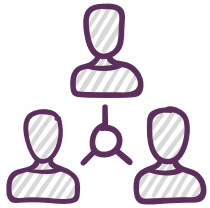
# College Connections

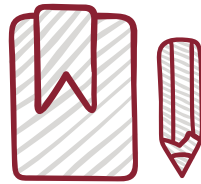

## Health Professions LLC

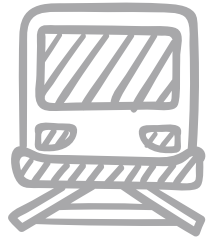

# Pioneer Connections

**Pioneer Connections LLCs are communities designed for students already admitted into special first-year programs. Students involved in these LLCs must take specific courses as described by their particular program, and can share a room with someone of a different major while still getting the LLC experience.**

## **ADELANTE LLC**

**The ADELANTE Leadership Program through the Office of Diversity, Inclusion, and Outreach, is designed for student leaders who want to cultivate their leadership development, strengthen cultural pride among their local communities, build mentor relationships and increase civic engagement. The four-year scholarship program is designed to intentionally provide comprehensive support for 40 students per cohort and continue developing and mentoring cohorts through degree completion. ## **President's Leadership Council LLC**

**Develop your leadership skills by being a member of the President's Leadership Council (PLC) LLC. Students in the PLC LLC take part in leadership based workshops during the fall and spring of their first year while completing service with other PLC students.**

## **Legacy Leaders LLC**

**Students participating in the Jane Nelson Institute for Women's Leadership Legacy Leaders program can make lasting connections in the Legacy Leaders LLC. This program will allow students to become more socially responsible and active members of their communities now and in the future.**

## **Terry Scholars LLC**

**Recipients of the Terry Foundation Scholarship are members of the Terry Scholars LLC. Terry Scholars are given additional opportunities to be involved in TWU campus life, and will complete the First Year Experience course in the fall semester.**



## **Texas Leadership Scholars LLC**

**Students selected for the Texas Leadership Scholarship are also members of the Texas Leadership Scholars LLC. The program connects cohorts of participating students with peer and professional networks and mentors, support leadership development, provide opportunities for undergraduate research, and offer job skills such as resume writing, social media use, communication, and collaboration.**

LLC students report an increased level of engagement with their university, as well as higher grades and rates of retention. Your Living Learning Community can also help you address academic concerns and give you access to academic support assistants and study hours.

# How to Apply

During the Housing application process, first-year students will also be able to sign up for a Living Learning Community, which will place them in a designated LLC floor with others in the same LLC. LLC applicants must also be placed in the same LLC to honor roommate requests. LLC spaces are limited and fill quickly, so apply early.
