# Pioneer Connections

## President's Leadership Council LLC

Develop your skills as a leader by being a member of the President's Leadership Council (PLC) LLC. Students in the PLC LLC take part in specific courses during the fall and spring of their first year while completing service with other PLC students.

## Terry Scholars LLC

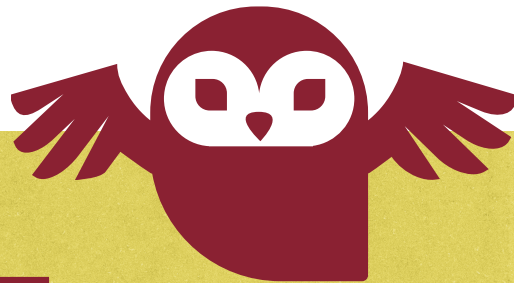

## Texas Leadership Scholars LLC

The program will connect cohorts of participating students with peer and professional networks and mentors, support leadership development, provide opportunities for undergraduate research, and offer job skills.

Your Living Learning Community can also help you address academic concerns and give you access to academic support assistants and study hours.



## How to Apply

During the Housing application process, first-year students will also be able to sign up at no cost for a Living Learning Community, which will place them in a designated LLC floor with others in the same LLC. LLC applicants must also be placed in the same LLC to honor roommate requests. LLC spaces are limited and fill quickly, so apply early.
