

REQUEST FOR RELEASE FROM THE UNIVERSITY RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT AND/OR BREAKING THE HOUSING/FOOD SERVICE CONTRACT

All TWU full-time single undergraduates who have not completed 60 credit hours are required to live in University residential communities unless one of the following exceptions applies.

- With children
- Active duty military or veterans of military service
- Living with parents or legal guardians within the commuting distance (40 miles)
- 21 years of age or older

Instructions: Please read the entire appeal form carefully and adhere to all requirements.

1. Complete all sections of the form and submit with all required documentation. Incomplete forms will not be processed or considered until all information has been appropriately submitted.

The following items must be included with the Request for Release from the Residency Requirement and/or Breaking the Housing/Food Service Contract appeal:

- 1. Signed letter of appeal from the student attached to this appeal form
- 2. Signed letter from the Parent(s)/Guardian showing support for reasoning listed by student in Letter of Appeal
- 3. Any and all supporting documentation
- 2. Appeal letters must contain and provide very specific detailed information supporting the appeal claim. For example, if medical or financial reasons are stated as the basis of the appeal, appropriate documentation must be provided from a professionally certified medical or financial establishment to substantiate the claim. These are legal documents please ensure accuracy of statements.
- 3. Submit this completed form along with all supporting documentation by attaching it to the Housing Exemption or Cancellation form in the Housing Portal.
- 4. Allow up to two weeks for processing of your appeal. Students will be provided with written notification about a decision. If under contract, approval does not exempt students from the contract breakage fee.

The following items are considered justification for breaking the contract and/or being released from the residency requirement:

- 1. Withdrawal from Texas Woman's University
- 2. Traveling overseas via participation in the Study Abroad program
- 3. Relocating to the Dallas/Houston campus to complete TWU clinical coursework
- 4. Personal hardship, which may include medical issues, death in the immediate family or a documented financial hardship (unemployment, reduced income-furloughs, loss of job, pay cut)

Examples of reasons NOT considered justifiable include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Signing a contract with an off campus housing provider
- 2. Wanting to live with a friend or family member off campus
- 3. Commuting from a distance greater than 40 miles
- 4. Receiving a financial aid loan
