This past month has been jam-packed with IPE activities – check out everything we've been working on below!



Highlights

- Nursing & OT Students attended a Clinical Skills Readiness IPE event this past week, which helped them improve skills that promote patient-centered health outcomes through hands-on activities and case study experience that focus on role responsibilities, communication, team reasoning and professionalism.
