

## TEAS Information for Prospective Nursing Students

***All prospective Nursing students are responsible for reviewing and understanding the information outlined in this document.***

1. All students submitting a NursingCAS application for entrance into the TWU BSN Program are required to complete the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) in order to be considered eligible.
2. The ATI TEAS exam is designed to assess a student's preparedness to enter a nursing program. The test consists of 170 questions. Questions are designed to test the basic academic skills you will need to perform in class in the areas of: Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language Usage.
3. The cost for the ATI TEAS exam for the TWU College of Nursing is \$122 per test.
4. ATI does not offer refunds or permit rescheduling of the TEAS exam if a student is not able to test on the day scheduled. Students are allowed to reschedule the test BEFORE the 48 hour time frame before the exam. We offer a 5-minute grace period after your scheduled test time. Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled test administration start time. Late arrivals will not be permitted to test once the exam has started.
5. Students achieving an individual score of 64% or higher, within EACH section of the ATI Entrance Examination, are eligible to apply for The College of Nursing's Upper-Division Program within the NursingCAS platform.
6. If an individual score of at least 64% is not achieved within EACH section of the entrance exam, students will have the opportunity to register for a 2nd exam.
7. Prospective nursing students are limited to two (2) attempts per admission cycle:  
Fall Admission Cycle; August 16th – February 1st  
Spring Admission Cycle; February 2nd – August 15th
8. The College of Nursing does not have a time stipulation in regard to retaking the entrance examination. However, we do ask students to explore practice test options and review their official score report to determine their areas of weakness. TEAS study resources are available for purchase through ATI's online store.
9. TEAS full score reports uploaded to the "Program Materials" section of the NursingCAS application must fall within a 12-month timeframe of the respective deadline. TEAS full score reports that are uploaded to NursingCAS and do not follow this policy will result in your application being invalid.
10. TWU is only offering the exam remotely through ATI Proctorio; you will not attend the campus for the exam.

11. To set-up your scheduled assessment with The College of Nursing, visit the ATI testing website ([www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com)) and review the “How to Register for TEAS” hyperlink on the TWU TEAS webpage.

12. Prospective applicants who would like to test with a TWU Proctor will select “Institution Remote Proctor-Nursing” and select TWU as their respective institution by searching “TX WOMAN U DENTON”.

13. TEAS scores will be available through your ATI account immediately following the exam.

14. Please do not purchase an ATI Transcript; simply download your free TEAS Full Score Report from your ATI Portal and upload the respective document to the “Program Materials” section of your NursingCAS application.

15. The following time limits will apply to the ATI TEAS, Version 7 (launched June 3, 2022):
