Language, Philosophy & Culture (core block 40)	3	← These 4 prerequisites can be satisfied by taking coursework that satisfies the <u>same Texas state core curriculum blocks</u> at another Texas state college/university, regardless of course equivalency. Students who transfer in with a completed core curriculum from another state institution do not have to take either of TWU's block 90 courses. Students who do <u>not</u> transfer in core complete will have to meet TWU's remaining core requirements as nursing program prerequisites. Language, Philosophy and Culture; Creative Arts; and the Component Area Option need to be completed prior to beginning nursing, but Multicultural Women's Studies can be taken after starting the nursing program, if necessary.

BOLD indicates the prerequisites that absolutely must be completed, have a posted grade, and be transferred to TWU prior to application to the Nursing program. Additionally, before students can apply, they must have a minimum of 46 credit hours completed (1st degree only) and have the remainder of the prerequisite coursework in progress or set to be completed before beginning the nursing program.

Courses in **BLUE** are not exactly equivalent to (but will substitute for) the required prerequisite. It is fine to take them if an equivalent option is not available.

- The content in these courses is structured differently than those at TWU. To get credit for these courses, you must transfer in BOTH from the same institution, to ensure that all content requirements been met.
- PSY or other non-MATH statistics may be substituted for Math 1703, if student has a completed TX state core curriculum from another institution, or meets the requirements for core completion at TWU.
