## Instructions for Running a What-If Degree Audit Evaluation

## Introduction

The mnemonic XPSPR (Proposed Student Program) provides an opportunity to produce a degree audit evaluation for a student on any other degree plan in the system without having to change the student's program. This is useful for students and advisors to identify progress gained or lost should a student decide to change majors.

## Instructions


- 1. Go to the mnemonic XPSPR.
- 2. In the Person Look-Up window, enter the name or Colleague ID of the student:




3. In the Academic Program Look-up window, enter the proposed (what-if?) program for the evaluation:




4. Select the catalog year for the proposed program:



5. The form will then populate the proposed program and catalog year specifics. Confirm that is the program for the what-if degree plan, and then detail in on the look-up next to "Evaluate":



6. The EVAL form will then open. The default run parameters will already be populated (see EVAL instructions document for more details on format options).



7. Save out to run evaluation.
