**Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene to
Bachelor of Science Dental Hygiene Dual-Enrollment Program**

The purpose of this ARTICULATED PROGRAM AGREEMENT ("Program Agreement") between **TEXAS WOMAN'S UNIVERSITY**, hereinafter referred to as "TWU," and **Austin Community College District**, hereinafter referred to as "ACC," is to serve as one of the program-to-program articulation agreements referenced in that certain Transfer Agreement between ACC and TWU effective as of February 12, 2021 (the "Transfer Agreement") which is known within as TWU No. C_2020_024. TWU and ACC shall be referred to hereinafter as the "Party or Parties." This Program Agreement will be effective as of the date on which this Program Agreement is fully executed by the Parties.

WHEREAS, TWU and ACC entered into the Transfer Agreement to enable students who successfully complete articulated courses specified in subsequently executed program-to-program articulation agreements, to transfer from ACC to TWU in a seamless transition without loss of semester credit hours toward the completion of a bachelor degree; and

WHEREAS, the Transfer Agreement indicated that the articulated program agreements will be separate, program-to-program articulation agreements documenting specific degree pathways, and will be reviewed and approved by the TWU and ACC senior academic leadership individually; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to establish the degree pathways for the Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene to Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene Dual-Enrollment Program Plan; and

WHEREAS, TWU and AAC now desire this Program Agreement to be approved and executed by the Parties under the parameters as set forth by the Transfer Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the Parties, TWU and AAC now agree as follows:

1. Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference contains the agreed upon degree pathways for the Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene to Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene Dual-Enrollment Program Plan (the "Dual-Enrollment Program Plan").
2. The Dual-Enrollment Program Plan will be implemented by the Parties according to the parameters as set forth by the Transfer Agreement.
3. The Dual-Enrollment Program Plan will be in effect for the same term as the Transfer Agreement.



The Parties hereto warrant and represent that upon execution hereof, this Program Agreement shall be a legal, valid and binding obligation on them and shall be enforceable against them in accordance with its terms. The individuals signing this Program Agreement warrant and represent that they are duly authorized to sign this Program Agreement for the for the Dual-Enrollment Program Plan on behalf of the Parties hereto.

TWU: 30 semester credit hours must be taken at TWU. If a student enters into Dual-Enrollment Program and is already core complete, electives will need to be chosen and completed at TWU to achieve the 30 hours at TWU. This will vary per student. See the TWU Catalog and meet with a TWU advisor to assist with current core options.

English I and English II must be completed prior to taking TWU courses.

*MATH 1342 or TWU **MATH 1703** is prerequisite for **DH 4713 Applied Dental Hygiene Research**

GOVT 2305 or TWU **GOV 2013 is prerequisite for **DH 4533 Oral Health Worldview**

***TWU may substitute **DH 3303 Process of Care for the Registered Dental Hygienist**

²Financial Aid-If TWU financial aid is needed, a minimum of 6 hours must be taken each semester. The student may elect to other options, which would delay graduation. Student should notify their TWU advisor if TWU financial aid is necessary for completion and an alternate plan would be created. Students should also ask their TWU advisor about scholarships available to Dental Hygiene students.

Degree is conferred in August of last year if all requirements are met.



Both institutions agree to maintain independent accreditation by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and the Commission on Dental Accreditation.

Both institutions require that students be in good standing, including meeting academic and ethical standards at both institutions in order to remain in the program.
