Degree Program Formula Funding by CIP Code

This is how it works: Once you know the appropriate CIP code and its funding code, which will be a number, you match it to the funding matrix below, far left column, to get the appropriate multiplier.

Example to calculate:

The Women's Studies CIP Code is 05.0207. On the higher education website you would see that the funding level multiplier for that CIP is 01. You see on the chart above that the multiplier for category 01 (Liberal Arts) is 1.0 for lower division courses and 1.75 for upper division courses. The current formula funding rate is \$55.85/ SCH. Therefore a lower division course will receive $\$55.85 \times 1.0 = \55.85 per SCH in formula funding (\$167.55 per 3SCH course). An upper division course will bring in $55.85 \times 1.75 = 97.74$ per SCH (\$293.22 per 3SCH course).

Remember to calculate formula funding only for year 3 and beyond.
